USE THE RIGHT LANGUAGE

Write or speak in a warm voice. Keep a conversational tone to connect with learners to make your content more engaging by:

Using human voice:

eLearning reaches people on an emotional level.

Don't: Giving feedback as "**Correct answer**" **Do:** Hubspot's example: "**That's correct! Nicely done!**"





Addressing the learner as an individual:

<u>Don't:</u> Use words "the trainee, the learners"

<u>Do:</u> Rephrase with more personal words:
"Imagine if you could XYZ..." or "Doing ABC will help you..."

Keeping the content concise to enhance readability:

<u>Don't:</u> Long lead-in, complex instructions as:

"If you are looking for a way to continuous reading,
please click the button "Read more"

Do: Keep it short and clear as: Click button to read more.




Infographic:
